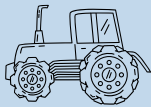
## What is SABR?

SABR’s members include stakeholders from every link in the value chain from feedstock growers to biodiesel producers, distributors, retailers, consumers, and infrastructure suppliers. These stakeholders, mostly small businesses, have invested heavily in meeting the nation’s goals of the Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS) program.

## What is Biodiesel?

Biodiesel is a renewable fuel produced from resources such as soybean oil, used cooking oil, and animal fat. It is the most cost-effective means to reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions from medium- and heavy-duty vehicles, providing numerous performance, economic, environmental, and energy security benefits.
